FLOOD BUCKET ITEM LIST

Please donate, if you can, any of the following items to help flood victims:

- (a) One five-gallon round bucket with lid
- (b) One 16 – 34 oz. bottle of liquid dish soap
- (c) One 50 – 100 ft. clothesline (cotton or plastic)
- (d) 24 roll of heavy-duty trash bags (33 – 45 gallon sizes)
- (e) One 32 – 64 oz. bottle of liquid laundry detergent
- (f) One scrub brush (with or without handle)
- (g) 36 – 50 clothespins
- (h) Two pairs of kitchen gloves
- (i) One 4 – 8 oz. pump spray air freshener (three solid or three gel fresheners also acceptable)
- (j) One 6 – 14 oz. pump spray insect repellent (pack of 10 – 20 wipes also acceptable)
- (k) 18 re-usable cleaning wipes – No terrycloth, microfiber or paper towels
- (l) Five scouring pads – No stainless steel or pads with soap in them
- (m) Five N95 particulate respirator dust masks (1 – 3mm thickness) – No surgical masks
- (n) One pair of work gloves – Cotton with leather palm or all leather
- (o) One 16 – 40 oz. bottle of liquid concentrate household cleaner
