HAPPY 320TH BIRTHDAY, JOHN WESLEY

On June 28, we remember John Wesley's birth 320 years ago in 1703. (His original birthdate was June 17, until England changed from the Julian calendar to the Gregorian calendar in 1752. He died in 1791. Wesley was an Anglican priest and theologian but also the founder of the Methodism sect. Along with his brother Charles, he was dissatisfied with the church of his time and was seeking a faith tradition that was more "ancient, biblical, and relevant to the lives of everyday people." In 1738, Wesley had a mystical, life-changing experience at Aldersgate in London where he felt his "heart strangely warmed. Love rather than dogma became the basis of Methodism. Preaching and teaching this new path required prodigious patience, courage, and energy."

"The whole world is my parish," Wesley told people, as he sought to preach Christ's gospel of grace in every place, even outdoors. He ignited the birth of Methodism in America and he published more than 400 books and hymns, while his brother Charles Wesley composed more than 9,000 hymns and sacred poems. Together, "they taught and practiced a form of Christian discipleship that held together faith and works, personal and social holiness, physical and spiritual concerns, works of piety and works of mercy."
