



In Paul's training, most people divided the world into two groups: Jews (God's people) and Greeks (all others). He echoed that in verse 16: "To the Jew first and also to the Greek." But his central thesis was that the gospel was for "all who have faith in God," not for any one favored group. Who (if anyone) have you tended to see as exceptionally favored by God?

Tuesday- Romans 1:18-25 What inner comfort levels do you need to stretch to trust and act on Paul's gospel message?
Wednesday- Romans 1:26-32

Thursday- Romans 2:1-16
